

Destrehan Plantation Food Vendor Rules
Festival Dates: Saturday & Sunday, November 14th & 15th, 2020—9 am – 4 pm
APPLICATION DEADLINE IS JULY 1, 2020

Destrehan Plantation requires all purveyors to submit a certificate of insurance covering all aspects of liability in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the participating purveyor and will hold the River Road Historical Society, dba/Destrehan Plantation harmless for any claims arising from the service of food product

Purveyor furnishes all contents of booths, including tables, chairs, etc.

Purveyor set up time is Friday, November 13, 2020 from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.

Purveyor set up time for Saturday, November 14, 2020 begins at 7:00 am. Festival closes at 4:00 pm, and purveyor should be off of the grounds by 5:00 pm.

Purveyor set up time for Sunday, November 15, 2020 begins at 7:00 am. Festival closes at 4:00 pm, and purveyor should be off of the grounds by 6:00 pm.

Purveyors enter the grounds on the road located in the back of the Mule Barn. Purveyors receive two (2) parking passes and will have a designated parking area once set up is complete.

Purveyors are responsible for collecting and paying both parish and state sales tax.

The assistant chairperson distributes parking passes, worker badges and necessary tax forms Friday, November 13, 2020 from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm.

Because of liability, Destrehan Plantation does not allow animals on the grounds.

Destrehan Plantation sets the above rules for the safety and success of the festival. We ask that you obey all rules.
