PLEASE NOTE:

- Any vendor selling plants will need a permit.
- Any vendor selling live flowers or floral designs will need a license.
- Vendors selling vegetable plants do not need a permit.
- Any Landscape Horticulturist, Wholesale Florist, Arborist, Landscape Architect who participates in our show needs proof of license.
- The Louisiana Horticulture Commission Rules and Regulations will be available on our website for all vendors to read.

Only vendors who sell items for the porch, patio, yard and garden will be accepted such as but not limited to:

- Plants & succulents (must have a permit to sell plants and succulents) grown by you.
- Trees and shrubs (must have a permit to sell trees and shrubs) grown by you.
- Live flowers (must have a license to sell live flowers and flower arrangements)
- Vegetable plants and herbs grown by you.
- Porch or patio furniture such as swings, rocking chairs, planters, and pillows
- Lawn furniture such as picnic tables and chairs, lounge chairs, and hammocks
- Porch or patio décor such as wind chimes, sculptures, ceramic planters and signs
- Fire pits and tables
- Fountains
- Mailboxes
- Arbors and trellises
- Privacy screenings
- Decks
- Outdoor shade screens
- Fencing
- Woodwork
- Outside door décor such as wreaths
- BBQ items such as pits, hand-made utensils, aprons, gloves, home-made BBQ sauces
- Picnic Baskets, utensils, etc.
- Outdoor artwork for flowerbeds, yard, and fences
- Bird feeders, houses and bird baths
- Dog houses and accessories
- Chicken houses and accessories
- Yard Games
- Outdoor Signage
- Parasols
- Macrame for the patio and yard such as hammocks, rope swings, porch swings, plant hangers
- Outdoor lanterns and torches
- Citronella candles
- Food items such as honey, fresh fruit and vegetables grown by you, and homemade seasonings
- Food items such as pickled vegetables, pepper jellies, fruit jellies (vegetables and fruit must be grown from your garden)
- Books on topics such as plants, gardening and herbs
- Organic home-made pesticides
- Exterior Home Improvement
- Small farm animals or pets such as chickens, rabbits, turtles (Please call the event coordinator to discuss any other pet or farm animal you may wish to sell)

The following items are not permissible in the spring show:

Clothing, aprons for inside the home and embroidery

Children's clothing, hair ribbons, toys, and dolls

Any type of artwork for the inside of the home with the exception of botanical themed prints

Food items themed for the winter or the Christmas holidays

Jewelry with the exception of botanical themed pieces

Ornaments for Christmas trees

Decorations for the inside of the home

Keychains, koozies, glassware, mugs, kitchenware

Bathroom related items such as soaps and bath beads

Candles with the exception of Citronella

Books (unless written about plants, gardening and herbs)

Destrehan Plantation Spring Garden & Pet Show Rules

Festival Dates: Saturday & Sunday, March 21st & 22nd, 2026

Destrehan Plantation requires all vendors to complete an application and list items to be sold in your booth.

State gaming laws prohibit raffles.

Vendors must submit the total fee with the application. We accept checks, money orders, and Venmo.

Each booth is for one vendor and will be in the name of that vendor. Vendors provide and set up their own tents. Approval is required from our chairperson for vendors with self-contained trailers. We do solicit volunteers to assist you with booth setup, but cannot promise volunteers will be available for everyone. One parking pass will be furnished per booth, and each booth entitles entrance for two (2) people. The chairperson distributes parking passes, worker badges and necessary tax forms the day of set-up.

Non-profit rescue havens or plant societies will receive one 15' x 15' booth space. You provide and set up your own tents. A maximum of six parking passes will be furnished per booth, and your booth entitles entrance for a maximum of six (6) people. If you require more than six people to operate your booth, you must submit a formal request via email to the event chairperson, Melissa Monica at melissa@destrehanplantation.org

The chairperson distributes parking passes, worker badges and necessary tax forms the day of set-up. Please remember you are responsible for collecting and paying both parish and state sales tax.

FRIDAY SETUP: Maintenance personnel opens gates at 8:00 am for vendor set-up. **There is no driving on the brick pathways.** Please bring handcarts, wagons or other equipment for setup. Once unloading is complete, please remove your vehicle from the gate entryway and park it in the parking lot closest to your booth. You may continue set-up until 5:00 pm.

SATURDAY SETUP: You may begin set up at 7:00 am. Setup must be complete before 9:00 am and all vehicles must be removed from the grounds by 9:00 am.

SUNDAY EVENING: Vehicles are not allowed on the grounds during removal of merchandise. Please make necessary arrangements to provide handcarts, wagons or other equipment for the removal of your merchandise.

Destrehan Plantation sets the above rules for safety and success of the festival. We ask that you obey all rules.
